



## **Abstract Submission**

The Scientific Program Committee (SPC) requires electronic submission of all abstracts for the IC –DRBG by June 31, 2017.

All abstracts and final papers must be sent through the Online Submission System and will be published in the congress proceedings with ISBN number.

Papers submitted will be peer-reviewed and all papers presented at the congress will be included in our university's journals: *Studia Universitatis "Vasile Goldis" – Life Sciences Series* (ISSN: 1584-2363), Vol. 27, Iss. 4 and the *Annals of the Romanian Society for Cell Biology* (ISSN: 2067-3019), Vol. 21, Iss. 1

Publication and Indexing

Full papers will be submitted by August 31, 2017.

Papers selected for oral presentation can be submitted for review in *Studia Universitatis "Vasile Goldis" – Life Sciences Series* and the *Annals of the Romanian Society for Cell Biology*, according to the guidelines of these journals. Both journals are indexed in SCOPUS, DOAJ, Index Copernicus, EBSCO.

Special information for PhD students

PhD students are especially invited to submit an abstract for a poster or oral presentation on their thesis topic, related to the general topic by June 31, 2017. Up to 20 PhD students with full papers accepted to the congress will be exempt from the conference fee.

Registration and conference fees

All participants, including paper/poster presenters, must register for the congress and pay the registration fee

Congress fees include: congress materials, proceeding with ISBN number, publication fee of full papers in our journals, coffee breaks and lunch, barbecue dinner and other events included in the congress program.

The congress fee should be paid after the paper is accepted for presentation, but **no later than** August 31, 2017.
